




4TH GRADE SUMMER READING PROJECT

Project for Number the Stars. You are required to do both activities below:

1. Make a poster that illustrates all the main characters in the novel. Be sure you illustrate the characters. Below each illustration, write the name of the character and describe that character's personality. Include the title of the book and the author on your poster.
2. Create a shoebox diorama of an important scene in the book. Include any important characters in the scene or items that depict the historical time of the scene, such as World War II. Write your name, date, and class on the back or bottom of your box. Write the title and author of your book somewhere on the front of the box. Choose and make a diorama for the MAIN setting of the book. Write 5 sentences about the scene and tape it to your box. Tips: You do not need to buy things in order to complete this project - look around your house. Present your diorama to the class on the first Friday that you return to school in August.

BOOK TWO IS:

Pick ONE from the list below and write a report about the plot (what happened in the story) of this novel. Your report should be 1 ½ pages written and it should include all the main events that took place in the novel. Don't forget to write the name of the book and the author on your report.
